

There were about 85 ladies in attendance, and they enjoyed a lovely spread of chocolate-covered strawberries, dainty cookies, and ice cream as they fellowshipped together before the meeting began. The tasty delights were just a preview of what was to come as the worship team, led by Amanda Walker, took their place. What followed was a wonderful time of praise and worship that ushered in the sweet presence of God. Women from 15 denominations were united as their hearts were uplifted to the Lord.

The theme of the meeting centered on military families.
Jeannette Ahmi, who served in the Air Force for 22 years, shared her testimony of being

Spotlight on Pastor Kevin Wright, Faith City Church

If there was one word that would describe the vision of Pastor Kevin Wright, it would be *building*. His vision for the newly-formed Faith City Church in Cocoa is to build families, build faith, and build dreams.

Although this is a new church in the area, Pastor Kevin and his wife, Terri, are not new to ministry. They were youth pastors for 15 years. In ministering to thousands of young people over the years, they realized that they had a desire to minister to whole families. That dream was born in February of 2008 as they began meeting in the Wrights' living room. In just a few months, the church grew to an average attendance of 100 people.

The Wrights took steps of faith along the way to lay the foundation for Faith City Church. In 1998 they felt led of the Lord to drop everything and move to Crowley,



Texas to attend Heritage of Faith Bible College under the leadership of Dr. Jerry Savelle. They graduated from Bible College in 2000.

Another faith step involved traveling on mission trips to Thailand and the Dominican Republic.

The Wrights were called back to their hometown area to minister to the many hurting people here on the Space Coast. Pastor Kevin has a passion to minister to people that are facing divorce, sickness, and poverty. His desire is to "reach people with life-changing messages from the Bible."

Faith City Church is interested in building kids, parents, and teens.

They have ministries that address each part of the family, and they also have a ministry to the surfing community. FLOW or Fellowship Led on Water, has a vision to save souls in the surfing community, no matter what the age.

The atmosphere of Faith City Church is casual. Pastor Wright usually wears jeans as he ministers, but dressing down doesn't change the power of the Gospel as it is preached. As Pastor Wright shares, "We are not only a place where people can build their faith, but a place where you can get connected, build relationships, and experience God."



One of the outreaches of Women Reaching Women is to be an arm of support to military families. Fran Barnhill, whose son Desmond is in the Air Force Reserve, recently attended a WRW meeting. Here is what she had to say:

"When I arrived at my first Women Reaching Women meeting, I did not know what to expect. I didn't know anyone or what these meetings were all about. I found the women very welcoming, warm, and friendly. I was very touched. At one point when we were singing, I got a bit overwhelmed because of the words of the song and the picture of the kneeling soldier that was presented. It reminded me of my son. Women Reaching Women is what I have needed and have been looking for."

Desmond is an Electronic Countermeasures Specialist flying on helicopters on the rescue squadron. This is his second tour of duty to Afghanistan. He has also served on two tours of duty to Iraq, and also to Kuwait and Turkey. He has been in the Air Force Reserve for 12 years.

When he's home in the states, he works as a Payload Specialist for the Shuttle Atlantis. He is also working on his Master's Degree in Airport Management at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.

We salute Desmond for his service and the sacrifice that he pays on our behalf as he puts himself in harm's way for our freedom. Our prayers are with him as well as all those serving our country around the world.

Brevard Is Seeing Pink!

As we approach voting day in this 2008 election year, colorful signs are everywhere promoting candidates from both parties and for all kinds of offices from County Commissioner all the way up to the President. Among this multitude of messages, pink signs for Women Reaching Women are popping up all around Brevard County. Women are seeing these signs, wondering what WRW is all about, and are calling the number to find out. Director Donna Long shares a few testimonies from these calls (initials are used in place of names.)

"D. F. saw a pink sign in Titusville and called. As I explained to her who we were, she burst into tears and said she was just released from the military and had just received a bad report at the V.A. hospital. She is only 23 years old and needed to talk to someone because she also suffers with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (severe depression). I was able to pray with her, encourage her and give her hope that she

would be okay. I assured her that we would stay in touch and others from WRW would also contact her with follow-up. Since then we have stayed in touch not only with her but with her mother."

"C.L. saw a Women Reaching Women sign in a different part of Titusville and wanted to know all about who we are because her sister had tried to commit suicide the night before and was hospitalized. I was grateful for the phone call because I was able to connect her with other P_{ink} S_{ign_S} all over B_{revard} health organizations that could support her sister in getting the extra help she needed."

"K.T. happened to see a sign in Merritt Island and called to inquire as to what Women Reaching Women was all about. As I explained to her, she was silent on

I thought possibly this was not what she was looking for until I told her that we gave away Blue Star banners to those who are deployed and Gold Star banners to the families whose loved ones have actually given their lives for our freedom.
