## FUNDRAISING

- ♦ **300,000 Veterans of Wars in Iraq and Afghanistan with PTSD or TBI (Rand Study)**
- ♦ **Single mothers 40% higher chance of clinical depression**
- ♦ **12 million women in the USA experience clinical depression each year (National Mental Health Assoc.)**

Fundraising is for the purpose of assisting women and children who suffer from depression caused by the demands of being a single parent or a loved one returns home from war and suffers from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (20% suffer) or Traumatic Brain Injury (19% suffer).

Our goal is to encourage these families to seek professional care in order to understand the healing process from trauma; and in doing so we help the whole family. WRW helps to provide funding for these services both to single mothers, military wives and their children.
